3) FACTS: 232 Million shoeboxes

delivered since 1993

11.9 Million shoeboxes collected in 2024

118,000+ Outreach events were led by trained local church leaders

The Greatest Gift Gospel Story booklet has been translated into 118 languages with ten new languages planned for 2025....and for 2025: translation into Braille! More than 100 countries receive shoebox gifts for boys and girls.

- 11 Nations collected shoeboxes in 2024: Australia, Austria, Canada, Finland, Germany, New Zealand, South Korea, Spain, Switzerland, the United Kingdom, and the USA.
- ** York County's Goal for packed shoeboxes for 2024: 16,801 and 16,803 came in, with one church reporting that they dropped off their boxes in Columbia, as it was convenient, but Lancaster County got the credit. 2025 Goal for York County: 19,001!

From the Pennsylvania - New Jersey region: 668,933 shoeboxes were collected, filling 91 sea containers. This region's 2025 goal: 736,801. The "1" at the end is because there is always another child who can be reached for Jesus.

- 4) \$10 "shipping" is Not just for shipping! These funds also are spent to train volunteers to be teachers; to print The Greatest Gift story booklet in their languages, such as "Kiribati" in the South Pacific, a geographically hard place to get to with this ministry. It also helps with the traveling expenses from our trucks to overseas...rough roads and rivers. Sometimes, shoeboxes must travel through one country to get to a destination within another country.
